


The second sector is dedicated to the period of the Caliphs and their efforts to spread Islam. Next is a portrayal of the daily life during the days of the Umayyad Caliphs, including a display coins, models of buildings and dams. A special exhibit on the Abbasian dynasty includes architectural designs and antiquities. A number of grave-stones bearing engravings and writings are on display to reflect the role of the Abbasids in the development of Arabic calligraphy as well as glasswork and pottery.

The gallery also includes a special corner featuring the Islamic civilization and the scientific developments during both the Umayyad and Abbasid periods.

The gallery concludes with a selection of antiquities from the Mamluke and Ottoman Empires.
